Sunday, May 5, 2019



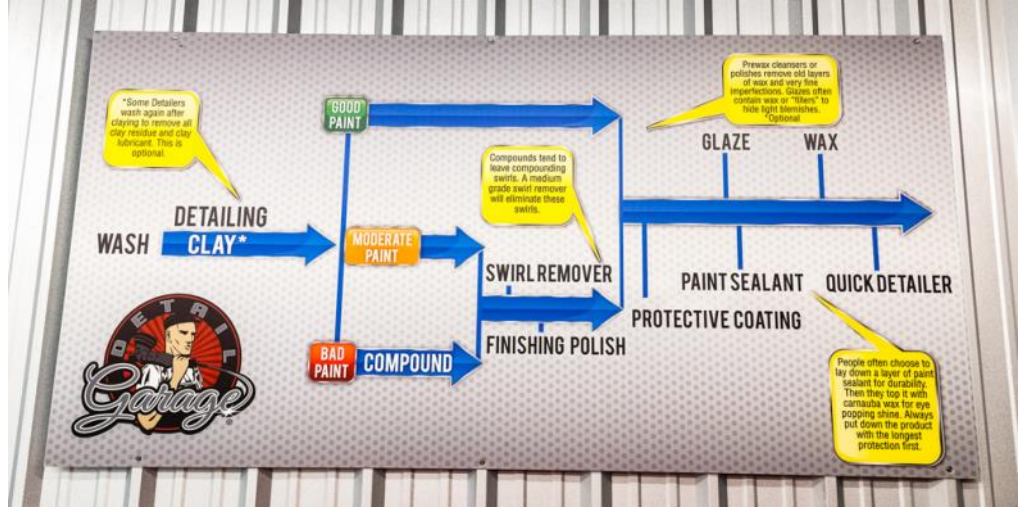
